MANGO: Fruiting trees – from 500g / tree at year 5 up to 2 kg / tree at year 8	1	After harvest
MACADAMIA: Fruiting trees - 350- 450 kg/Ha Or 80 – 120 g /m2 under tree canopy	3	Panicle emerg. After fruit set Post harvest
OLIVES: Fruiting trees - 750 kg/Ha or 0.5 to 0.75 kg per tree per year of bearing to max 4 kg	1	Late Winter to Early Spring
BANANAS: Fruiting plants-500 kg/Ha along the row	4	August Oct / Nov Jan / Feb April / May
High Chill STONE FRUIT: 650-800 g/tree	1	Early Spring
Low Chill STONE FRUIT: 500 g / tree	1	Bud break
100 g / tree	1	Post harvest
500 g / tree	1	February
APPLES: Bearing trees- 500 g / tree	2	Late Winter Late Spring
GRAPES: 250 – 400 g / vine	1	Late Winter budburst
PALMS: Established bearing- 300 g / tree/app	4	Oct, Dec, Feb April

ANNUALS: 50 g (1 handful) per m of row	1	Preplant
ROSES: 200 g (4 handfuls) per m2 of bed	1	At planting
100 g (2 handfuls) per m2 of bed	1	August
100 g (2 handfuls) per m2 of bed	1	Bud formation
CAMELLIAS & AZALEAS: 50 g / m2 per application	2	Late Aug, Feb
BULBS & CORMS: 100 g / m2	1	Preplant
